Candidates deliver a 3-minute speech at a public event, covering their biography and main electoral program ideas.

Teams navigate a press conference, facing questions from rival team members playing journalists.

In a dramatic twist, accusations are made against the candidate, leading to a crisis management scenario.

The program concludes with celebrating victory and a paintball "wargame" where teams protect the president from assassination attempts.
